Goulburn Valley (GV) Health is a Regional Public Hospital and Health Service for the Hume Region of Victoria, with main campuses located at Shepparton, Tatura and Rushworth. The main campus in Shepparton is the major acute referral hospital for the sub region. Additional sites are also located in Shepparton, Seymour, Benalla and Wodonga. GV Health provides a range of acute, subacute, mental health, aged, primary health and community services across the Goulburn Sub-Region within the Hume Region.

CREATE Outstanding encompasses foundation elements of the *Goulburn Valley Health Strategic Plan 2024-26* to link GV Health's purpose, values and our Culture of Care with fundamental organisational systems and processes. GV Health is striving to achieve CREATE Outstanding in every interaction with the people services are provided for as well as how staff work with each other.

ROLE STATEMENT:

The Registrar/Advance Registrar – Palliative Medicine is directly responsible to the attending Physician for day-to day patient management, and ultimately to the Chief Medical Officer, or in his/her absence, the appointed Deputy.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES, ACTIVITIES AND DUTIES:

- Attend ward rounds with supervising consultant.
- Daily review of palliative patients, keep clear documentation, manage clinical work with the direction of the consultant.
- Admit palliative patients, conduct in reach consults with other team members (including Clinical Nurse Consultants), and Review new referrals to the department.
- Attend regional palliative care clinic, Joint Home visits with consultant, Nurse Consultant or Hospice team.
- Attend Multidisciplinary meetings, Oncology Clinic and Monthly M&M meetings.
- The Trainee shall assist with registrar, intern and medical students teaching.
- The Trainee can be contacted for medical advice by other Emergency Department staff regarding patients with Palliative medical problems.
- Be pro-active about discharges and ensure discharges occur smoothly and early in the day.
- Attend clinics as rostered and be proactive about specialty learning.
- Participate in Quality Improvement, Clinical Audits, and Research.
- Provide a high-quality service to internal customers and consumers that reflects best practice and adds value to GV Health
- Assist the organisation in achieving clinical effectiveness by providing the appropriate systems, information or services to clinical areas

1. Provide quality and safe clinical care for consumers

- Ensure consumers, families/representatives or carers are provided with timely information and are involved in decision making about their care planning and treatment
- Accept accountability for own actions and seek guidance when a situation exceeds experience and/or knowledge
- Uphold and protect consumer rights, maintain strict confidentiality and continually practice to the principles of open disclosure
- Comply with best practice healthcare standards, legislation, and GV Health's Clinical Governance Framework and clinical practice guidelines
- Consumer feedback and complaints are responded to appropriately to ensure that issues are resolved and quality and safe clinical care is provided
- Maintain accurate and current clinical records ensuring documentation meets professional and legal standards
- Promptly report vital consumer observations that are outside the normal range as per clinical guidelines
- Ensure an effective discharge from hospital or services that reflects the needs of the consumer.





2. Develop and maintain collaborative relationships with all disciplines

- Collaborate and communicate with all members of the health care team to achieve desired consumer outcomes
- Respect the decisions and actions of others
- Contribute to interdisciplinary team meetings and clinical education sessions to facilitate consumer care goals.

3. Support and participate in evidence-based programs to evaluate and improve the quality of consumer care and outcomes

- Maintain current knowledge of clinical practice
- Actively participate in identifying where improvements can be made to the quality of consumer care
- Participate in clinical audits, research, process redesign and accreditation against healthcare standards to ensure ongoing clinical practice improvement and the quality of consumer care.

Teaching

- Attendance at Department meetings.
- Participation in journal presentations and lectures.
- Organise departmental teaching, and arrange to be a part of Clinical Audit presentations
- Participate in Medical Student Teaching, Grand Rounds and Journal Clubs.
- Participate in regular in service teaching on the ward and run the Departmental Teaching program
- Participate in the GV Health CPD programme and contribute to the interesting cases section
- Organise meetings with Radiology Dept to review interesting images
- Facilitate CBDs, mini CEXs and DOPS for the juniors and arrange to have these reviews for self with the Consultant
- To be familiar with The Australian Curriculum Framework for Junior Doctors, which is an educational template outlining the learning outcomes required of prevocational doctors, to be achieved through their clinical rotations, education programs and individual learning, in order to promote safe, quality health care.

4. Commit to ongoing professional development of self, other employees and the profession

1. Delivery of Service

- Participates in weekly Outpatient Clinics
- Completes all patient related documentation.
- Ensures all complex cases receive appropriate follow up.
- Liaises and communicates with the multidisciplinary treating team
- Contributes to team meetings and educational activities.
- Actively and regularly participates in peer review patient related activities.
- Participates in departmental research projects and audits.
- Responds to on-call commitments within an appropriate timeframe.
- Works effectively with all internal and external stakeholders.
- Conducts and assists in family meetings.
- Close liaison with specialist members of the palliative care service, (anaesthetists and psychooncologists).
- Works with allied health professionals to optimize patient care and discharge planning.
- Follows hospital policies and procedures.
- A team worker that encourages an environment which attracts, develops and retains staff who work together to achieve a shared vision of excellence

KEY SELECTION CRITERIA:

Mandatory

- Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency as a Medical Practitioner
- Highly effective communication and interpersonal skills, including the ability to relate positively with and appropriately with patients and others
- Registrar level of experience in medicine, oncology, general practice or related disciplines.
- Candidates undertaking Pain specialist training and/ or Clinical Diploma in Palliative Medicine will be preferred.
- Ability to provide work in a multidisciplinary team setting.
- Ability to establish and maintain good interpersonal relationships with medical staff and other disciplines. High level of motivation
- Professional collegiality towards peers and the wider health care team
- Evidence of full immunisation against COVID-19
- Satisfactory National History Criminal Check prior to commencement of employment
- Satisfactory Victorian 'Employee' Working with Children Check prior to commencement of employment
- Completion of a Commonwealth of Australia Statutory Declaration prior to commencement of employment.
